61. The Chair welcomed everybody to the meeting and asked if there were any interests to declare. None declared

- 62. Apologies had been received from Cllr Barry Goodey (holiday) & Cllr Dudley Hughes (ENC) and were duly accepted by the Council.
- 63. Mr Croft asked to Council to justify the increase in precept which it did and he left with a greater understanding of what the Council pays for from its precept.

 - a) Cllr Dollimore reported from the JAG meeting that the police had been taking speed surveys along the main road and that there was consensus for a 40mph speed limit rather than the changing limits at present and he was pressing for the footpath between the villages to be repaired properly
